At a special meeting of the Board of Trustees of Whitney Benefits held last evening, formal action was taken to carry out the instruction of Mr. Whitney's will. A Whitney Memorial Building will be constructed to include the business offices of Whitney Benefits, a reading room, restrooms and a gymnasium. This building is to be built contiguous to the presently planned YMCA building with ready access between the two buildings. A committee of the Whitney Benefits Board will be appointed to work closely with the Building Committee of the YMCA in making general plans. It is the feeling of the Board of Trustees of Whitney Benefits that the combination of these two buildings will make possible a facility that will contribute greatly to the enjoyment and benefit of all the residents of the County of Sheridan and carry out Mr. Whitney's instruction that a building be built and used in an educational way and for the advancement of the morals and health of the Community.
